



# APIN-UNIMED RESEARCH PRACTICE FACILITATION PROGRAM

*Building Research Resilience in the Development Space in Nigeria*

The Research Practice Facilitator Training is a capacity-building initiative of APIN Public Health Initiatives and the University of Medicine, Ondo. The initiative aims to support the capacity development of public health specialists and researchers working in the development space in Nigeria in research designs and methods. The training consists of an intensive 6-day residential workshop and a 6-week mentorship designed to equip participants with key skills in research conceptualization, protocol, and manuscript writing. Graduates are expected to produce policy-relevant peer-review publications at the end of the training program

## • Eligibility

The call is open to people working in public health space with graduate degrees in any science-related course and 5 years of experience in relevant public health programs including those in Infectious disease programming, reproductive and sexual health, Gender and social development.

## • Application requirements

- CV of not more than 5 pages including contact details and a list of referees
- Statement of interest of not more than 150 words
- Certificate of completion of a graduate degree program
- Letter of recommendation from immediate supervisor.

**NOTE: Training fee is paid after being granted admission.**
